

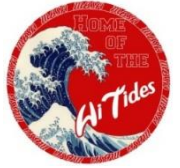

White, pastel or light beige knee length dress (anything shorter or longer will show)

**OR**

White or beige dress shirts (collars & button down) and black dress pants

**Shoes:** Heels (make sure they are a manageable height) and dress shoes

- Stay away from colors (remember the gowns are sheer)
- Stay away from dark colors, stripes/polka dots on dresses, they will show through your gowns and look like stains in pictures
- NO JEANS
- NO SANDALS and NO SNEAKERS
- NO PURSES

- NO POLOS or T-SHIRTS
- NO JACKETS
- NO CELL PHONES

***Schedule for Graduation Procedures***

**PLEASE NOTE: YOU MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE FOR REHEARSAL TO WALK IN GRADUATION. ATTENDANCE WILL BE TAKEN EVERY MORNING.**

**Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> – Meeting after underclassmen awards ceremony in auditorium. Report to 1st block. Seniors will be called down to the auditorium at approximately 11:10 am. The MEETING is MANDATORY!**

**Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> – Senior Awards Ceremony in Auditorium, Rehearsal in Gym: Report to 1st block. Seniors will be called down to the auditorium at approximately 7:45 am. MANDATORY REHEARSAL.**

**Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup> - Rehearsal in gym: Report to 1st block. Seniors will be called down to the gym for rehearsal for the rest of the day. All seniors will report to second lunch. MANDATORY REHEARSAL.**

**Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup> – All seniors report to the gym during first block. Cap and Gown and ticket distribution will begin at around 12:00PM. THIS IS THE ONLY TIME TO GET CAP AND GOWN/TICKETS.**

**Early release (on 5/29, 5/30 and 5/31) only if parents signed students out ahead of time (see attached letter).**

**Graduation – Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup> – Watsco Center at UM AT 9:00 AM, line up by 7:00 AM**

**Ticket & Cap and Gown distribution will begin at around 12:00PM. THIS IS THE ONLY TIME TO GET GRADUATION TICKETS.**

#### Watsco Center Venue Policies

The staff will be using metal detecting wands and bag checking prior to entering

#### **Prohibited Items**

The following is a partial list of items that are prohibited at all Watsco Center events and is subject to change. Please contact Guest Services for specific policies/information. For the safety of our guests, the Watsco Center does not permit the following items into the Arena.

- Weapons, pepper spray/mace, flares, fireworks
- Food, beverage, alcohol, cans, bottles, flasks, coolers, drugs, illegal substances
- Pamphlets, stickers, product samples
- Skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, helmets, chairs, beach balls
- Laptop/Tablet computers, 2-way radios, laser pointers, flashlights
  - Tablet computers larger than 9.56 inches (243 mm) (H) x 7.47 inches (190 mm) (W) X 0.34 inches (8.8 mm) (D)
- Balloons, permanent markers, spray paint
- Noise making devices: air horns, drums, whistles
- Cameras: no flash/professional photography, tripods, monopods or selfie sticks.
- Bags, backpacks, briefcases, duffle bags larger than 14" x 14" x 6"
- Signs/Flags/Banners/Posters: may not be larger than 11" x 17" or attached to a pole/stick
- Masks are prohibited and may not be worn at any time while inside the arena.
